

HOW MANY TAPE RUNS TO USE AND WHAT IS THE BEST SPACING TO USE BETWEEN YOUR TAPE RUNS

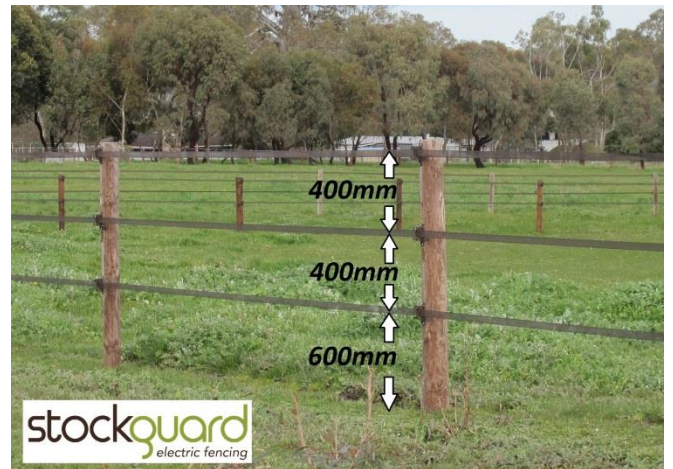
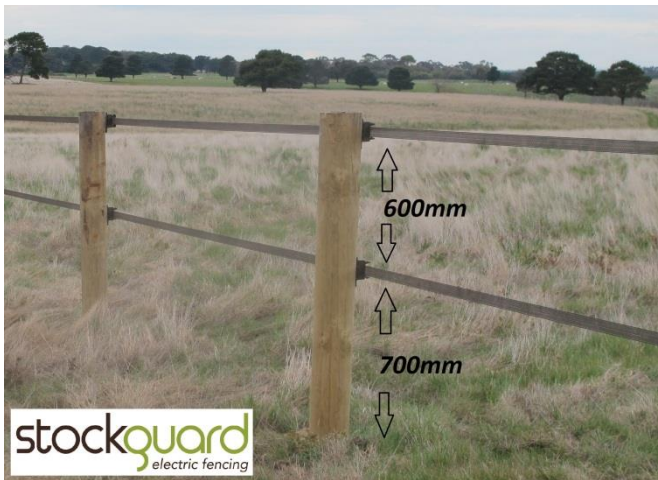
How to make the right decision on the number of tape runs to use based on your individual requirements.

To create that permanent visual and mental barrier for your horses use these quick and easy guidelines to help provide the right fence for your horses and property.

Number of Tape Runs	Suggested Use
Four tapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Boundary fences ✓ Contain small ponies (escape artists) ✓ Stallion paddocks
Three tapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Mares and foals ✓ Internal fences ✓ Great visual along a driveway
Two tapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Internal fences ✓ Horses over two years of age and above 14 hands



With your post set approximately 400mm in the ground, use these examples as a guideline for spacing between the tape runs.
